In view of the “Guidelines for Handling Copyright in Examination Papers” adopted by the University, new measures have been implemented for using the Examination Database on the Library Website.

From now on, access to the Examination Database is restricted to current students and staff of the University only. Also, before downloading examination papers from the Examination Database, student or staff will be required to log in and complete an online undertaking, for not to use the examination papers for any purpose other than research or private study, nor to disclose the copy to any third party.

Celebrating the 50th Anniversary of the Re-establishment of Lingnan University in Hong Kong - Art Exhibition of Professor Siu Fai Wing (23 Sept - 06 Oct 2017)



Prof Siu Fai Wing, the renowned artist in contemporary China, was invited to hold an art exhibition and display over 270 art pieces of Prof Siu at at Leung Fong Oi Wan Art Gallery and Fong Sum Wood Library.

A calligraphy piece on our motto “Education for Service” written in Niao-chong Zhuanshu (鳥蟲篆書) and a collection of art pieces were presented to Lingnan University in commemoration of the University’s golden jubilee in the opening ceremony.

2017 Mini Book Fair (21 Oct 2017)

The Library organized a Mini Book Fair on the Information Day on 21 Oct 2017. Over 2,800 books were put on sale and a total of 915 books were sold. All the money raised was donated to the Library Development Fund for the future development of the Library’s resources. Thank you very much for your support.



Copyright and Education Talk (10 Nov 2017)

The Library invited a senior solicitor of the Intellectual Property Department of the HKSAR Government to deliver a talk on copyright in relation to educational issues and examination papers on 10 Nov 2017. The speaker firstly gave an overview of the copyright laws, followed by an elaboration on the restricted acts of the copyright laws, as well as permitted acts in the copyright laws for research and study use, including fair dealing of copyrighted educational materials and examination papers.

Pre-Show of HK INT'L Ex-Libris SHOW 2018 (20 Oct - 03 Nov 2017)

 Ex-Libris (the Latin word for "bookplate") is a small print or decorative label used to stick inside a book for indicating its owner. Ex-libris became recognised as a highly imaginative form of miniature art from late 19th century. To promote the appreciation of the Ex-Libris, Hong Kong Ex-Libris Association organized the exhibition that have displayed over 200 Ex-libris. The opening ceremony cum seminar were held on 24 Oct 2017 to let the Lingnan community to know more about Ex-Libris.



Meeting at the Crossroads: Collaboration across Departments and Institutions - A Joint Conference Presented by the Library and ITSC (17 Nov 2017)

 The Library organized a joint conference with ITSC on 17 Nov 2017. It is one of the celebrations of Lingnan University's 50th Anniversary. It presented several campus collaboration projects from the perspectives of liberal arts universities' in Hong Kong and in the United States.



About 120 participants attended the conference. Apart from the ITSC and Library colleagues from other 7 UGC-funded universities and libraries, there were representatives from the Education Bureau and from 10 other higher institutions from Hong Kong and Macau. The conference has successfully provided insights and sharing on collaboration across different parties in higher education institutions.
